Money Explained - Part 1 of Community Outreach, Education and Empowerment!

1 City money comes from a few different sources:

Grants
Taxes
Services and Fees

2 The money goes into either:

General Fund

Restricted Fund

3 The General Fund may be used for Council approved decisions.

4 Restricted Funds are often Grants and Services and Fees.

5 The Water Bill payments, for example, are services and fees and can only be used for water related projects.

6 The use of Restricted Funds are determined by the source of the money.

7 For example, the Fruit Growers/ Riverside Park Grant money can only be spent on the park.

8 A Grant is usually outside money required to be invested on very specific projects.

9 Sometimes projects are comprised of City Contributions and once committed cannot be reversed.

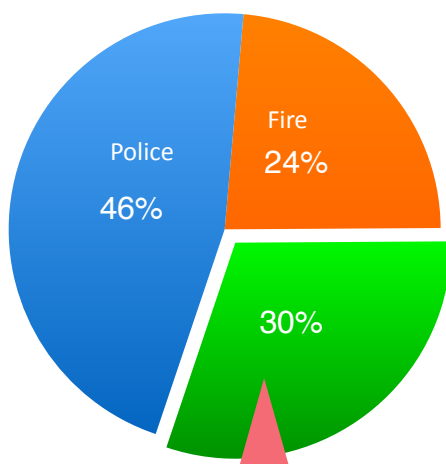

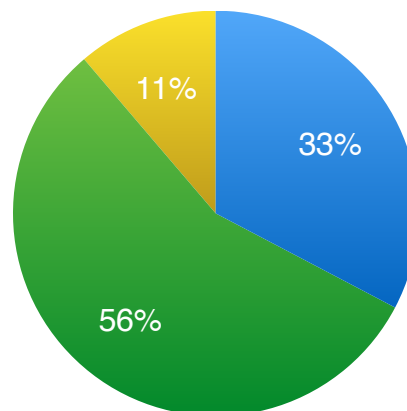
